CUAUHNÁHUAC'S PROGRAM INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING SERVICES:

- 1 - 6 hours of classes daily, Monday - Friday, in Normal Intensive Language Program (Classes range from one to maximum five students), 2 weeks of study.
- 2 - 13 nights living and interacting with a Mexican host family, (SHARED ROOM – 3 meals a day).
- 3 - Airport Transfer from the Mexico City International Airport to Cuernavaca (One way).
- 4 - Orientation for new students and School supplies: Workbook, notebook, pen, and artisan workshop materials.
- 5 - Cuernavaca Downtown Tour to see the Main Cathedral, Jardín Borda, Cortes Palace, the Zócalo (Main square)
- 6 - Volunteer Work Program: Every Monday participants work within low-income communities, orphanages and community organizations on education and service projects. The program is geared towards establishing a relationship with the community and orphans while completing projects and teaching the basics of English through games, songs, etc. Students will assume the expenses generated for this activity.
- 7 - Spanish/English conversation exchanges: Tuesday & Thursday evenings. Students speak 30 minutes of Spanish, 30 of English, and have the opportunity to meet Mexican students studying in our English Division.
- 8 - Monday evening movie: each Monday, a Mexican/Latin American film is shown.
- 9 - Cultural Workshops: Tuesday and Thursday afternoons: Metal plate work and dancing lessons.
- 10 - Access to computers and e-mail daily, to receive/send messages, using: student@cuauhnahuac.edu.mx
Internet service for additional cost (approximately \$1 USD/hour)
- 11 - Doctor available to students in the mornings Monday through Friday, for minor needs
- 12 - Access to all Cuauhnahuac's recreational facilities
